What's next for Rockville Trails? At least three things are already in the works.

First and foremost is the preparation of the management plan, which will guide us for years to come. A critical component of the plan is the cultural and natural resource assessments that are being conducted by Nomad Ecology and Solano Archaeological Services. We anticipate that the management plan will be complete by the end of 2013. Public access features such as trails, benches and signage will not be built until the resource mapping is complete.
